Agricultural Scholarship

The Jasper County Farm Bureau, Incorporated recognizes the need of agricultural students in their efforts to further their education. Therefore, Jasper County Farm Bureau, Incorporated will offer a \$4000 scholarship to any Jasper County high school graduate entering their freshmen year at a four-year agricultural school. The applicant must be enrolled in an agricultural major.

Jasper County Farm Bureau, Incorporated will offer one scholarship per year to the most qualified applicant who resides in Jasper County. The applicant or his/her parent must be a Farm Bureau, Incorporated member.

A panel of qualified independent representatives will make the final selection on a scholarship winner. The selection will be announced at the school's Senior Awards Night.
